Any omissions or falsification of the CDC # 106 (Visiting Questionnaire) is sufficient reason for denial of visiting privileges.

1.  Before this Department can process your visiting application the information indicated below is needed.
2.  Your request for visiting privileges with the aforementioned inmate has been denied for a period of **6 months** based on facts indicated below:
3.  Information received from our background investigation has revealed that you may have falsified and/or omitted all or part of your arrest/criminal history.
4.  Information received from our background investigation has revealed that you may have outstanding warrant. Please attach proof of clearance to this letter and mail to the Visiting/Processing Center.
5.  Information received from the Department of Motor Vehicles reveals that you have a **Failure to Appear**. Please notify this office with proof of clearance and attach the clearance to this denial letter and return. You must possess a valid photo ID in order to visit.
6.  Before your background investigation can be completed and your visiting questionnaire processed we require verification of the disposition of your case. This document can be obtained by going to the court and securing a Minute Order, which will provide us with all the required information. Forward a copy of the Minute Order to this office. Date of arrest/detention/citation:
7.  If you are currently on probation, parole or outpatient status, you must provide written consent from your Probation or Parole Officer on official letterhead and mailed directly to this office, before your visiting questionnaire can be processed. If you have been discharged from Parole, a Certificate of Discharge (CDC-161) is required. If you are on Summary or Informal Probation, a court docket will be required from the Municipal or Superior Court granting Summary/Informal Probation.
8.  Per California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 3172.1 (b) Reasons for disapproving a prospective visitor include but are not limited to the following: (2), "The prospective visitors has one felony conviction within the last three years or two felony convictions within the last six years or three or more felony convictions during the last ten years."
9.  Due to your ex-felon status and/or arrest history, you must first write to Warden P.L. Vasquez and request permission to enter State Property for the purpose of visiting. In this letter you must provide detailed information as to your relationship to the inmate, how long you have known him, your current employment status, and any information to assist the Warden in making a decision. If you have been discharged from Parole, a Certificate of Discharge will be needed. It is a felony for a former inmate to come on prison grounds for any reason without prior approval of the warden.
10.  Per CCR, Section 3177(c)(8) you must provide proof of prior personal contact or correspondence with the inmate before or during his incarceration.
11.  The earliest date you may reapply for visiting consideration is **June 21, 2005**. You are required to resubmit a CDC-106 if you wish to be reconsidered for visiting privileges. Do not provide any requested information until that time.
